AUDIT EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Pier C Leamington Site is located in the heart of Leamington. The site receives Onions from its own farm during the growing season and approved suppliers when needed. Two lines are available in the packaging area. The line one is cleaning, grading, packing, and palletizing the Onions and the second one is used for packing small quantities or repacking. The product is stored and distributed to Canada and USA. The wood bins stored from the farm are transported by forklift and then dumped into line 1. The product dumped is inspected in a conveyor to eliminate bad quality products, the Onions are transported through an inclined conveyor until an Onion topper and brusher to be graded and sized. The product is transported by a conveyor to be weighed and bagged in different presentations 50 lbs, 3 lbs, 2 lbs, and 10 lbs. The smallest quantities are sent to a fixed inclined conveyor where the product goes to line 2 where the product goes to automatic weighers and then packed and labelled. The product is again inspected in a carousel bagger by the employees and palletized according to the customer's requirements. Only line two was working during the day of the audit with products from approved suppliers, the Onions harvesting season does not start yet at the farms. Thirteen employees were working during the audit day in the packaging area.
